The theme in focus is "ICT and Crisis Management".

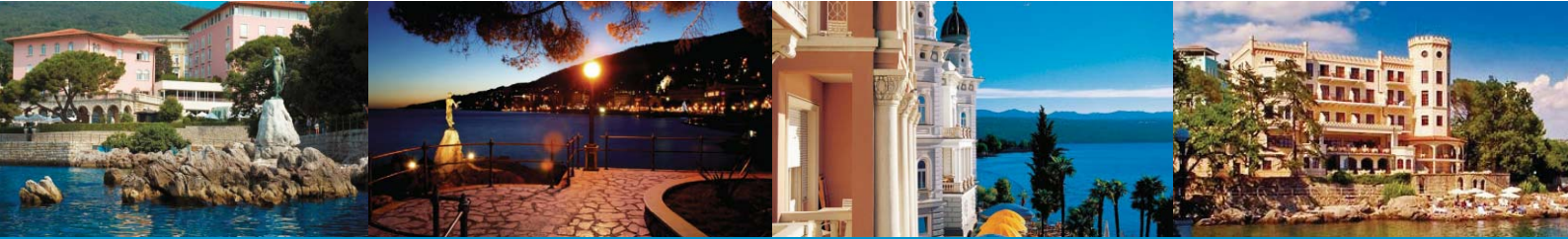
As part of the CTI conference the **presentations** of the information and telecommunication products and services are welcome as well.
