The conference offers an opportunity for all those interested in researching Electronic Commerce to meet in a specialised venue to discuss research activities, findings and experiences. Attendees at the conference are encouraged to participate in discussion of all papers presented.

As an addition to the conference, presentation of electronics products is welcome as well.

LOCATION

Opatija, often called the Nice of the Adriatic, is one of the most popular tourist resorts in Croatia and a place with the longest tourist tradition on the eastern part of Adriatic coast. Opatija is so attractive that at the end of the 19th and beginning of the 20th centuries it was visited by the most prominent personalities: Giacomo Puccini, Pietro Mascagni, A. P.
